## REP. FIELDS AT WORK FOR YOU

### SUPPORTING OUR CHILDREN

**Youth Employment Tax Credit** - AB 837 creates an income and franchise tax credit for businesses that hire high school students for summer employment who have a 2.0 G.P.A. or higher.

### INVESTING IN OUR FUTURE

**Emerging Target Investment** - AB 838 develops a \$20 million program that allows 30% Wisconsin Income Tax Credit to those investing in businesses started and operated by people of color, women, and service-disabled veterans.

### JOBS

**Urbanshores Initiative** - Urbanshore is an alternative to offshoring that can provide the same lower costs perceived to be associated with offshoring. It will fill the gap between retiring IT and HVAC employees and potential employees by providing technical training, apprentice project work, and entry level skills to the underutilized urban populations.

**Technology Training Bill** - AB 540 provides income and franchise tax credits to employers that provide: technology training to employees who work in the areas of vehicle technologies including design, frame, internal combustion engine, and casting technologies.

- ✓ 2.5 G.P.A. or higher

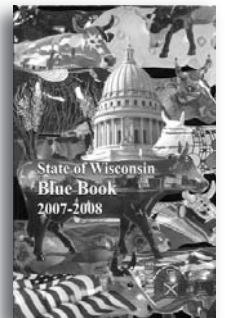
