Underage Drinking

Right now, an underage person can drink alcohol in a bar or restaurant in Wisconsin if they are accompanied by a parent, guardian or spouse who is of drinking age. Do you support making it illegal for people age 17 or younger to drink alcohol in a Wisconsin bar or restaurant without any exceptions?

Sobriety Checkpoints

Wisconsin is one of 12 states that does not allow sobriety checkpoints. Do you support providing local law enforcement the option of conducting sobriety checkpoints to help deter drunken driving?

Health Care

Do you support a universal health care system that would cover all Wisconsin residents?

Oil Company Taxes

The Governor proposes taxing the profits of oil companies and prohibiting them from passing the tax on to motorists. Do you support this proposal as a way to help address the state budget deficit?

School Choice

By the end of this school year, private schools in the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program will have received over \$870 million in taxpayer money to educate eligible Milwaukee students from lower income families since the program began in 1990. Do you support requiring Choice schools to administer state standardized tests and release the scores by grade and subject so parents and taxpayers can see how well each of these taxpayer-funded schools is performing?

Child Protection

Thousands of children nationwide were abused by members of the clergy between 1950 and 2002, and in some cases this abuse was never reported.
