

HEALTH CARE:

1. Are you covered by health insurance?
95% Yes 5% No
2. Would you favor a government run health care system that taxes employers to provide health care coverage for all citizens, but somewhat limits your choice of doctors & clinics?
16% Yes **69%** No 15% Undecided
3. Currently, due to low government reimbursements for services, there is a shortage of available dental care for the poor. Would you support a proposal to create a two cent tax on each can of soda to provide funds for this purpose?
43% Yes **48%** No 9% Undecided

TRAFFIC & PUBLIC SAFETY:

4. How do you feel about our current set of penalties and the enforcement of laws relating to drunken driving?
18% Too harsh **52%** About right
30% Too lenient
5. Do you support proposals which would mandate that all gasoline would contain a minimum percentage of ethanol?
16% Yes **66%** No 18% Undecided
6. Regarding the use of cell phones while driving, which alternative do you favor?
15% All cell phones including hand-held continue to be legal.
31% Talking while driving, hands free, without holding phone is legal.
48% No phone use at all while driving is legal.

7. Do you support proposals which would allow local municipalities to pass laws prohibiting certain dangerous breeds of animals as pets (i.e. pit bulls, wolf hybrids, lethal snakes or other dangerous species)?
75% Yes 18% No 7% Undecided
8. Do you support a proposal that would allow people to obtain a permit to carry a concealed firearm if they have passed a specified training program, paid a fee, and have no history of crime or mental illness?
57% Yes 34% No 9% Undecided
9. Would you support proposals allowing for primary enforcement of Wisconsin's mandatory seat belt law (motorists could be stopped and ticketed for this violation alone)?
33% Yes **63%** No 4% Undecided

10. Currently the minimum age for hunting with a gun is 12. Would you support proposals which would lower the age for hunting with a weapon to 10 years old as long as the child is within arms length reach of a parent?

GENERAL:

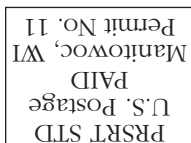
