LEGISLATION FOR 2007

Following are some of the bills that I have authored so far this session:

■ ATV Access (AB 59)

ATVs are becoming more and more popular not only up north, but all over the state. This bill allows ATV riders to make use of public roads to gain access to trails from their homes or places of lodging, provided that the local municipality passes an ordinance.

This bill requires that voters at the Conservation Congress spring hearings be residents of Wisconsin.

■ Increased Penalties for Drunk Pilots (AB 89)

The current penalty for flying an aircraft while intoxicated is a fine of \$10-100. That's absurdly low. This bill brings penalties (including possible jail time) in line with current DUI penalties.

■ Corn-Fuel Tax Credit (AB 171)

More people are using corn to heat their homes. Corn is not exempt from sales tax like wood or propane, however. This bill provides the same sales tax credit for corn used for home heating.

In addition to the legislation I've already introduced, I'm working on bills that will increase access for recreational vehicles, provide more affordable insurance and improve our children's education.

■ Rural Doctors Initiative (AB 90)

Our rural areas are medically underserved. This bill creates a loan program for resident medical students who agree to practice medicine in rural Wisconsin for six years after graduation.

■ Conservation Congress Voting (AB 91)

The Conservation Congress is one of the people's outlets into setting state natural resources policy. However, some groups have attempted to skew the results by bringing in out-of-state activists.
