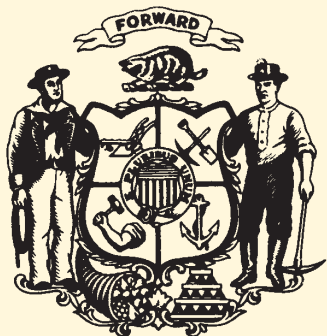

- 1. Many people complain about the high tax burden in Wisconsin. What do you think about the following taxes?
Income Tax, Property Tax, Sales Tax
2. In the past two years the cap on municipal property taxes has resulted in an average statewide increase of 5.6%. The Governor's budget now proposes to double that cap. Do you support this proposal?
3. Governor Doyle's budget allocates \$1 million to continue engineering studies for the proposed Kenosha-Racine-Milwaukee (KRM) commuter rail line. Should this money for additional engineering studies be funded?
4. Due to unknown costs and benefits, KRM continues to be an extremely controversial issue. Should any proposal to fund KRM with increased taxes or fees be required to pass a binding public referendum?
5. Currently homeowners pay a real estate transfer tax to the state of Wisconsin whenever they sell a home. This costs the average family in Racine County \$450 to \$800. Governor Doyle's budget doubles this tax. Do you support this provision?
6. Would you support the creation of a school choice program in Racine similar to the program that operates in Milwaukee?
7. Do you support increasing the tax on cigarettes from \$.77 per pack to \$2.02?
8. Wisconsin is facing a large deficit in our transportation account due to recent transfers from this fund to other programs. In order to replenish (or protect) the fund, would you support any of the following proposals:
a.) Increasing the gas tax?
b.) Increasing the vehicle registration fee by \$20?
c.) Implementing a toll system?
d.) Implementing a constitutional protection to stop raids on segregated funds?
10. Should taxpayers be required to pay for health insurance coverage for the same-sex partners of government employees?
11. Do you support providing in-state tuition to illegal aliens?
12. Governor Doyle has proposed a 1% tax on hospitals that will raise \$418 million over the next 2 years to provide more Medicaid funding. Do you support the creation of this so-called "sick tax"?
